## <u>Pirkko Home Liberation Center Ministry</u>

*Dmitry Gusev:* Plavsk Pirkko Home, Tula region: Construction of the second floor continues and the first floor is being completed. We bought building materials:

tiles for finishing bathrooms and shower rooms, as well as a toilet for the disabled. Thank God, the brothers from that district are helping. We've landscaped the area around the house by laying out some cement pavers. Our farmyard has grown: chickens, geese, pigs and sheep. A ready-to-use sauna (banya) was donated to us. Now there is a place for relaxation and conversations. Brothers from the neighboring church in Suvorov come to us once a week for Bible study and fellowship.

We were invited to help build a church in the city of Smolensk. We worked there for two weeks helping the brothers. In addition to helping with our hands, we took part in the city celebration of 15 nearby villages, and won first place for kindness and friendly attitudes with people. At the moment, we are actively helping in the construction of a shelter for homeless animals. New guys are coming to the program, and now there are quite a few of them. Together we are working on our music ministry and preparing a program for church services.





<u>Zheleznogorsk Pirkko Home</u>, Kursk region: in October our center celebrated its 13th anniversary! Guests from other rehabilitation and adaptation centers joined us from different cities to praise the Lord! The church was full of men and women whom God saved from destruction, the captivity of sin, and a dark life that led to eternal torment. There were so many prayers, poems & testimonies of God's miracles! It was a great encouragement for the believers! We continue to feed the homeless with hot meals every week, together with our church.



In October, a two-day "Pirkko Home Alumni Retreat" was held near Solnechnogorsk with another rehabilitation ministry, "House of the Word". About 100 people came. The pastors edified us with the topic "Show your Faith by your Good Deeds," since the current trends in churches, and among alumni, is many words, but little action.

## The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire Magazine Ministry


