It is impossible to fully judge the impact that the ministry of the *Gospel Behind Barbed Wire* magazine has had in Russia over the last 17 years. Literally hundreds of thousands of inmates have been confronted with the Gospel of Jesus Christ through its colorful pages. Writing from his prison cell in central Russia, Sergey told us that "nothing touches my heart like your magazine." He pled with us that we would never stop sending him the publication, saying, "please do not rob me of the hope found in your magazine which helps me to live."

Russian Christian Radio is uniquely placed to publish and distribute the *Gospel Behind Barbed Wire* magazine to prisons throughout the former Soviet Union. Many prisoners just like Sergey write to tell us how they depend upon our publication for spiritual encouragement, nourishment and comfort. We are a spiritual lifeline for them. Many have come to faith in Christ through our magazine and have been discipled as followers of Jesus Christ through local prison fellowships which spring up in response to the bi-monthly publication.

"Peace and grace to you from the Lord Jesus Christ! I knew nothing of God as a child and I headed down the wrong path. At 17 years of age, I was introduced to the penal system where I first sat in prison for fighting. With this incident, it all began. Before I realized it, three terms had flown by and only in the fourth term, again in prison, did I think about my existence. I looked at God's Word for the first time. My mother had given me a Bible as a gift. I was far from God, but He was with me even though I could not see Him. He performed His work in my life and protected me. Only now do I understand His care and concern...

I began to go to the prison church. It was there that I first saw the magazine, The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire. These magazines do a good work in the hearts of prisoners! In the scriptures we read, "do all to the glory of God" (1 Cor 10:31). For this reason, I praise the Lord and give Him the glory! The Lord Jesus Christ - He is the way, the truth and the life, and all glory and worship should be rendered only to Him.

I was released from prison in 2008 and went to church where I was baptized. I now correspond with brothers in prison. I pray for the brothers that God will be merciful to them, so that by His great mercy those in bondage will be changed, just as He brought about change in my sinful life. I am thankful to the Lord that He delivered me from many, many sins; I have made some progress, but I still strive to walk in all His ways. Above all things, this I know and believe -- that He will not leave me! In everything I give thanks to the Lord!"

The Lord touched me



"My name is Yury. The Lord touched me here in prison and I believed in the love of God and His mercy, given to all people, including me. In this same place, I first saw The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire magazine. That was in 2002, and at that time I did not understand what I held in my hand, but it interested me very much. I saw written on its pages, words of joy and thankfulness expressed by the authors of the articles. I did not understand at that time, the reason for their joy while still living here in prison, and why they were thanking God for His mercy when they were suffering punishment. But one thing I did understand - I wanted to be happy and thankful like them. As I read the testimonies of brothers and sisters, I tried to compare my own life with theirs. Sometimes their situation was very similar to my own and I was happy to realize, 'I am not the only one like this! There are others who can understand me and with whom I can relate!'

Time has passed, and now I also am able to thank God for my prison term and for this punishment. I am thankful to God for this magazine and for all that work on it; for all the prisoners that have come to God and for their examples and testimonies. The magazine

is a good counselor and a good critic. I am always amazed at how its articles touch on the very thoughts and problems at hand! Sometimes, during a discussion, there arises a question, and then the magazine comes and deals with the very theme under discussion! The magazine puts everything in place. Praise God for His effective power!"
